Personal Care and Assistance- HCA 140

This practical course will offer students the opportunity to acquire personal care and assistance skills within the parameters of the HCA role. The course is comprised of lectures and supervised laboratory experiences which assist the students to integrate theory from another course to develop caregiver skills that maintain and promote the comfort, safety, and independence of individuals in community and facility areas.

Instructor Qualifications:

- Current full practicing registration as LPN/RN/RPN with the BCCNM
- Minimum two years of full-time nursing experience (1 year=1400 hours), with relevant knowledge of the Canadian health care system including,
Experience in working with older adults with complex health needs.
Experience or orientation (e.g., shadow shifts) in-home support and multi-level/complex care
- Demonstrated ability to teach adult learners (PID diploma equivalent education or previous HCA course teaching experience with satisfactory references and student course evaluations.
- Evidence of completion of coursework in Indigenous cultural safety and humility (e.g., San'yas Anti-Racism Indigenous Cultural Safety Training or an alternative training program
- Excellent verbal, written, and computer communication skills.
- Experience in MS Teams and Moodle learning platforms
- Proven ability to work both independently and within a collaborative team environment.
